- JAPAN IS THE 2ND LARGEST UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUP IN THE WORLD.
- JAPAN HAS ONE OF THE HIGEST SUICIDAL RATES IN THE WORLD.
- ONLY 36% OF JAPANESE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS FEEL THEY HAVE WORTH AS A PERSON IN A RECENT SURVEY.
- THERE IS ONE MISSIONARY PER I 50,000 JAPANESE PEOPLE. THIS IS THE 2ND LOWEST RATE IN THE WORLD NEXT TO CLOSED ISLAMIC NATIONS.

#### How God is working in Japan

- About 30 children come to our English class and worship time held at our church every Wednesday. Their moms come and stay for the worship time. Most of them come from non-Christian homes.
- Two girls who come to our English class have made a decision to follow Christ and they will be baptized this Easter.
- More than 15 moms and their babies come to our play date at our church every Friday. We read Bible stories and sing praise songs.
- God has opened the door for us to lead an English Bible Study at a local church every Sunday night. There are several adults who are seeking and interested in becoming a believer.
- We are continuing the disaster relief effort by delivering fresh food to more than 200 homes and spending time with them monthly.
- More and more Japanese friends are asking about our faith. Several
  of them asked us to spend one-on-one time to study the Bible.
